 - Purchasing people for sex is a crime and perpetrators must be held accountable.

 - The Action Network works to actively engage individuals in challenging the social structures that normalize prostitution/sex trafficking.

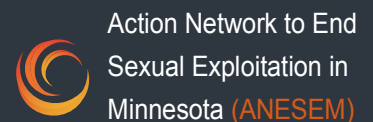
WHO WE ARE:
