



Vision 2020 is a national project focused on advancing gender equality by energizing the dialogue about women and leadership. Its first public event took place on Oct. 21-22, 2010, when a congress of national delegates, representing all 50 states and the District of Columbia, met at the National Constitution Center in Philadelphia to launch an action agenda to move America toward equality by 2020, the centennial celebration of the 19th Amendment. Delegates gathered to have a conversation exploring issues that perpetuate inequality in eight topic areas including arts and culture; business, law, and finance; communications and media; education; engineering, science, and technology; health; philanthropy, faith, and volunteerism; and politics and government.
